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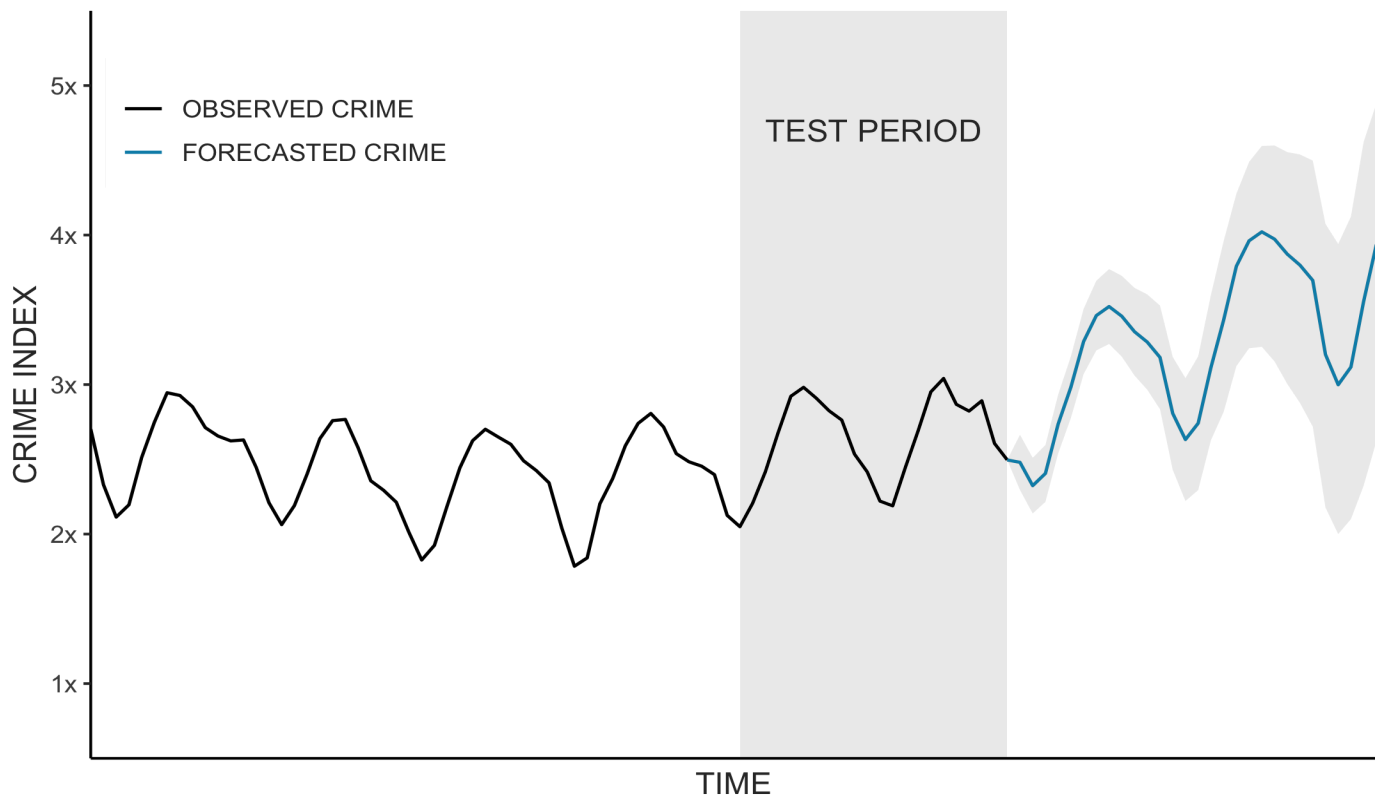
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PINKERTON CRIME INDEX

To forecast crime, we use state-of-the-art machine learning algorithms that ingest evidence of past crime, together with a wide variety of slow-moving structural variables and fast-moving indicators of recent disruptions. The variables employed for prediction are suggested by leading theories from criminology, including the premise that crime requires the coincidence of three factors: a suitable target, a motivated offender and the absence of capable guardianship.



Pinkerton's UK Crime Report tracks total crime, violent crime, property crime and public-order violations at the neighbourhood scale for all regions in England, Wales, and Northern Ireland. For each crime category, the index expresses risk as a multiple of the national-average level. A score of 1.0x indicates average risk, while a score of 2.0x indicates twice-average risk. Forecasts include a 95% confidence band constructed using overall model accuracy during an out of sample test period.



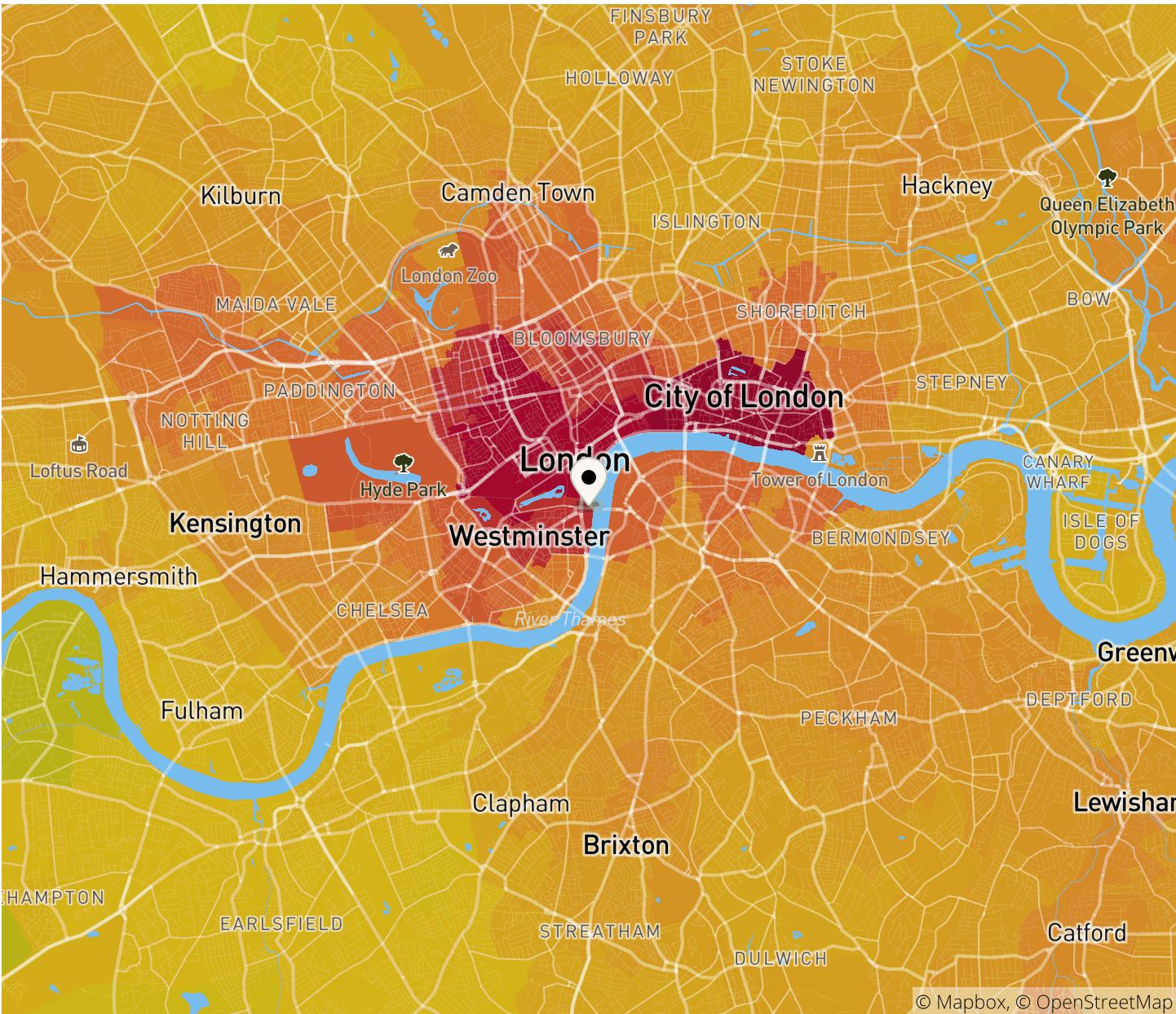
TOTAL CRIME RISK: NEIGHBOURHOOD SCALE

CRIME SCORE

3.0x

Total crime risk in your neighbourhood is 3.0 times the national average. The map shows total crime risk for a set of neighbourhoods surrounding your address. Light shades of green indicate low crime risk, while yellow, orange and red indicate areas with increasingly higher risk. We use observed crime counts in space together with data on a wide variety of neighbourhood characteristics to estimate crime risk at a finer spatial scale. 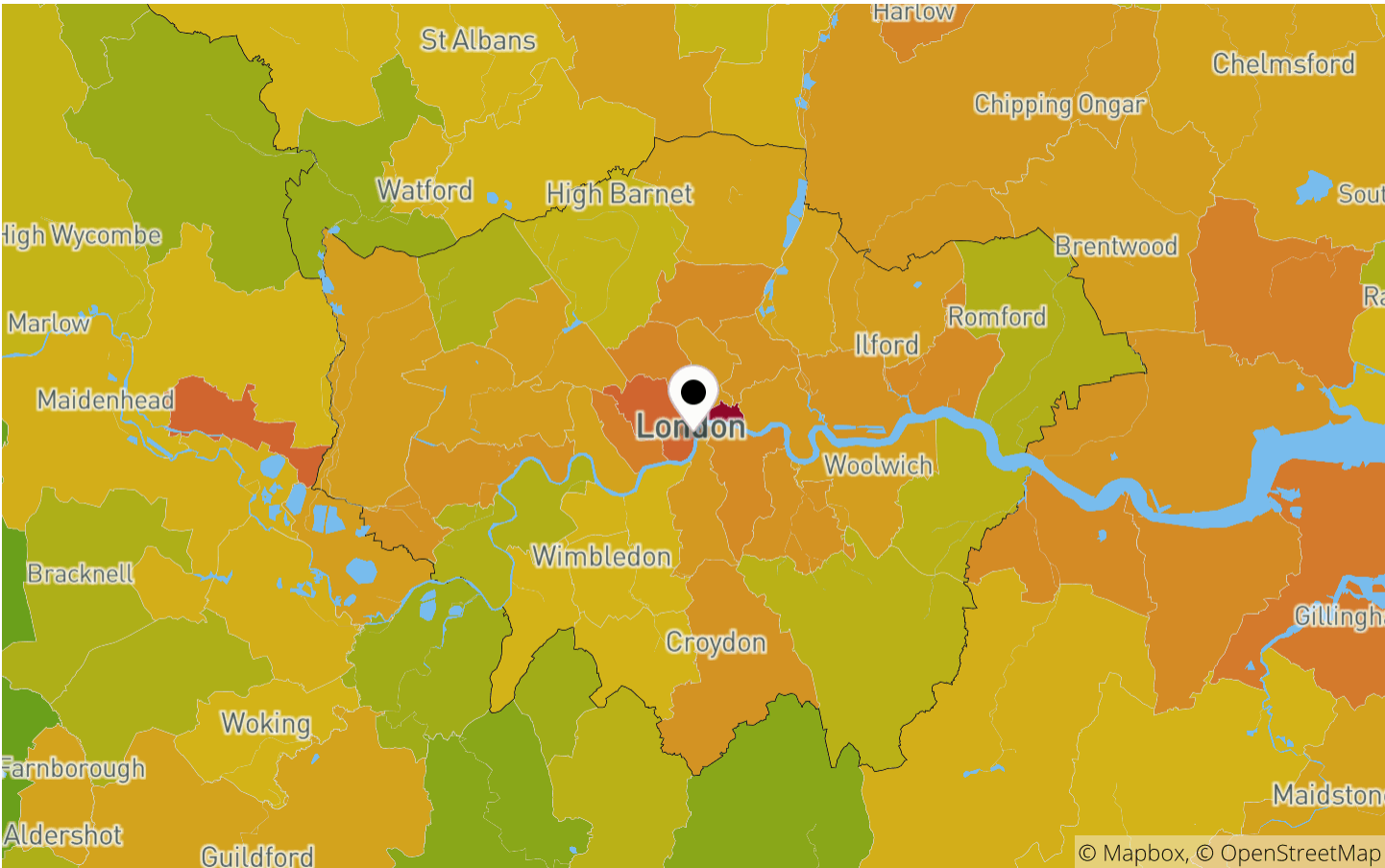

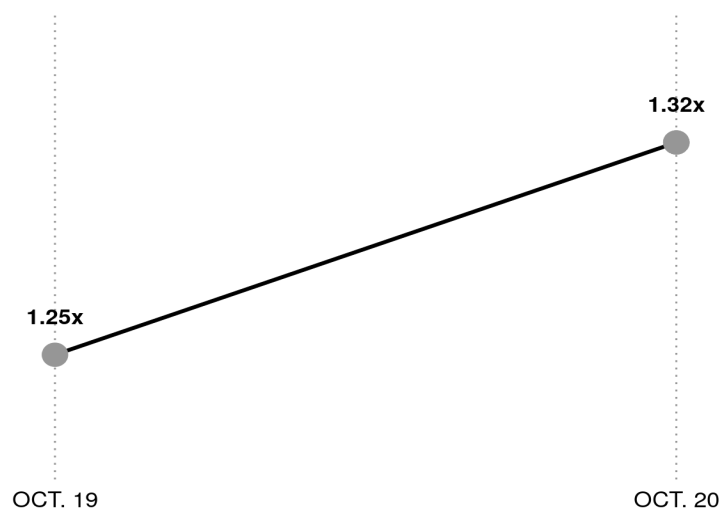
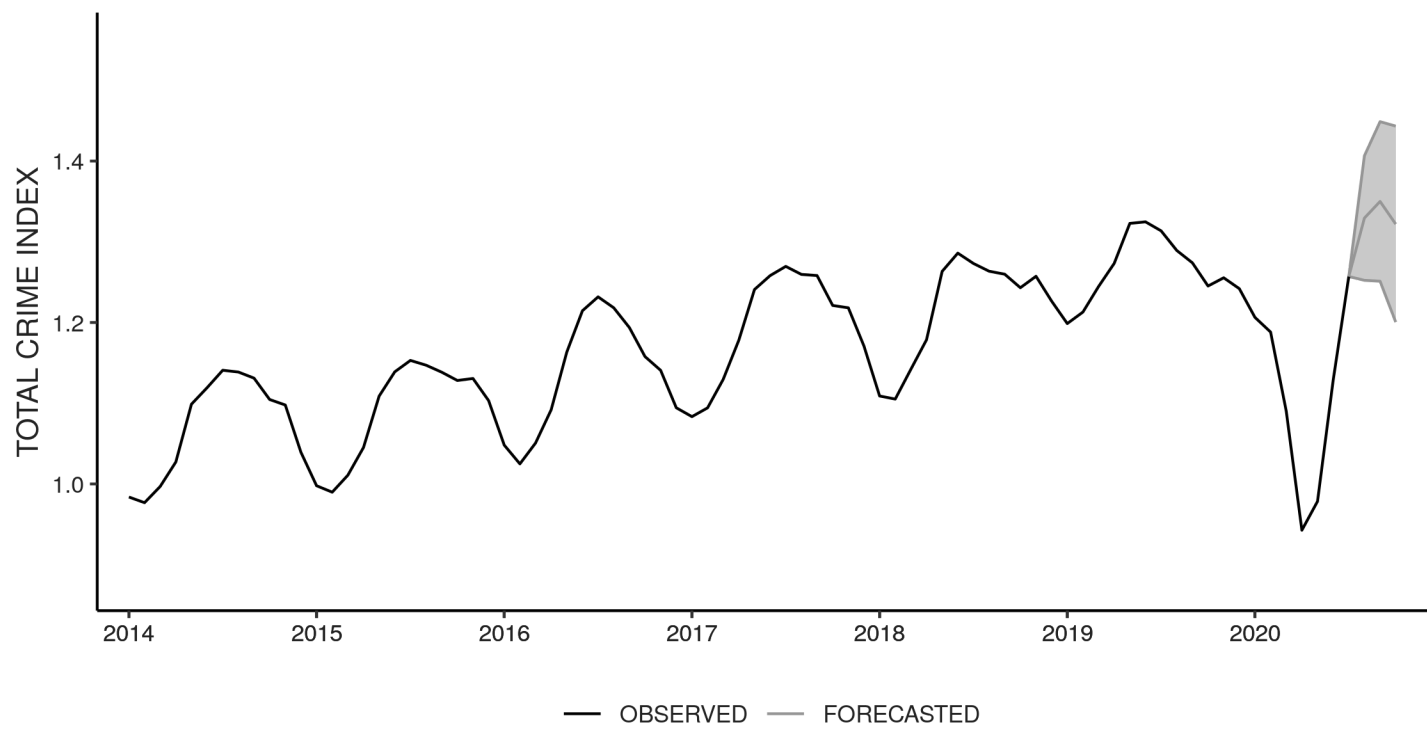

LONDON TOTAL CRIME RISK OVER TIME

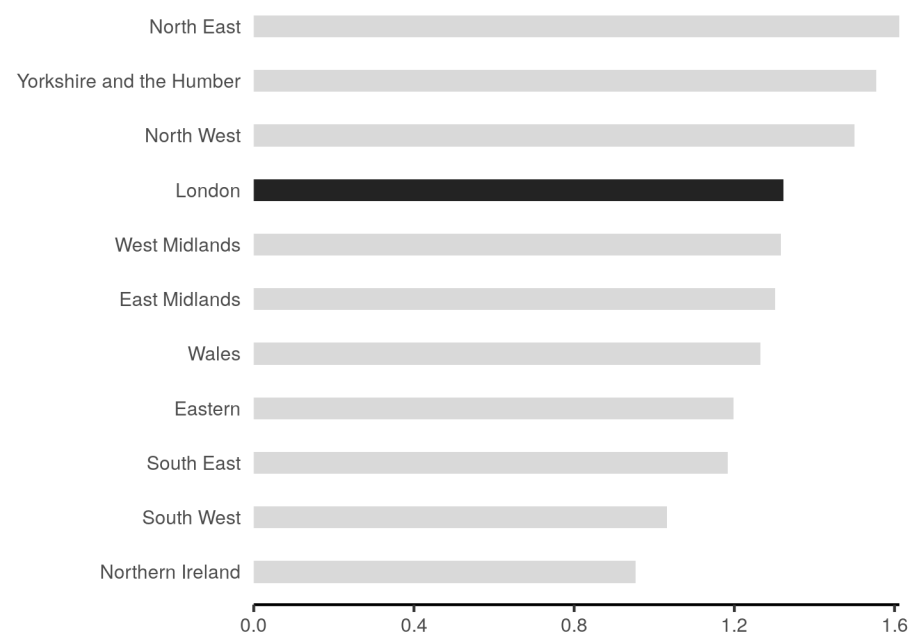
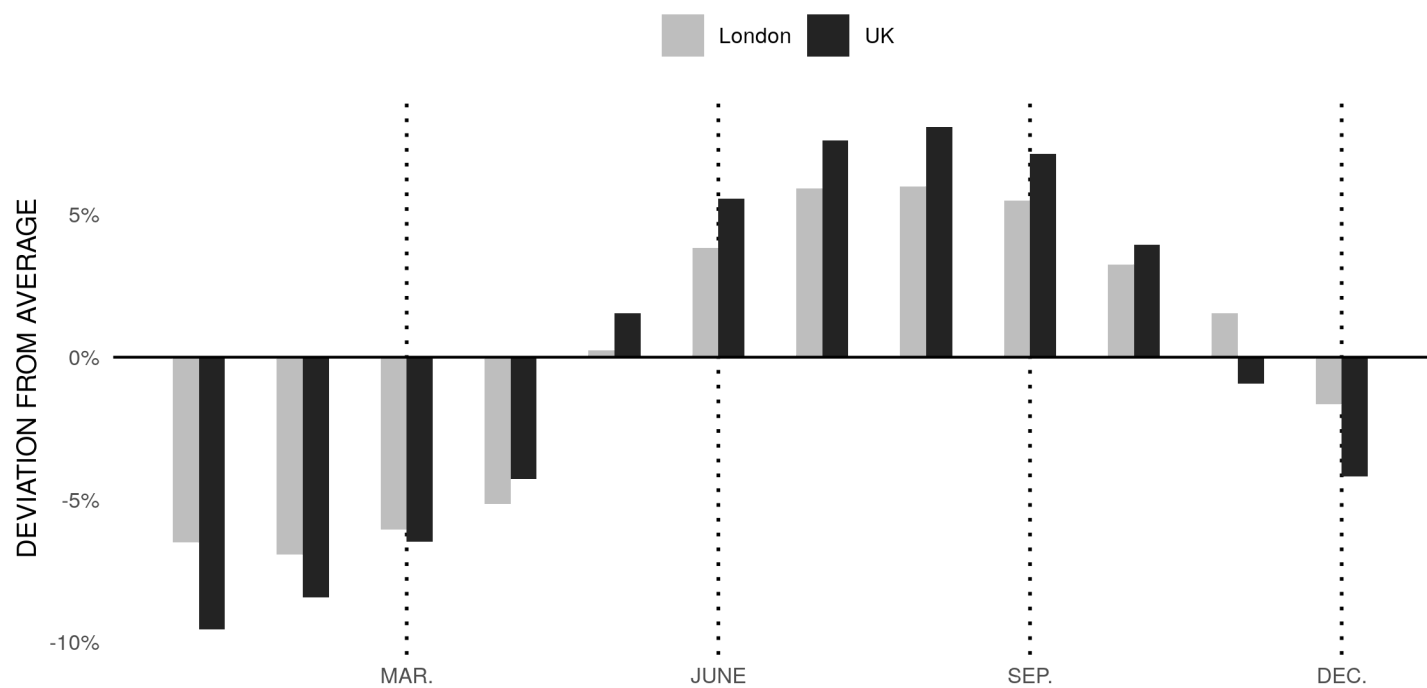

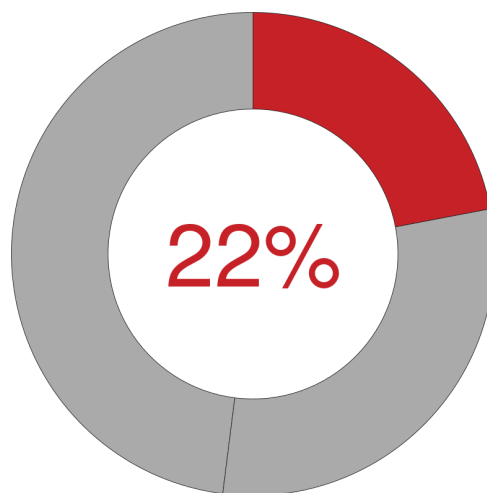


The figure shows total crime risk across regions in the UK, sorting regions from highest to lowest risk. The London region has the 4th highest total crime risk across the group.

COMPOSITION OF LONDON CRIMES

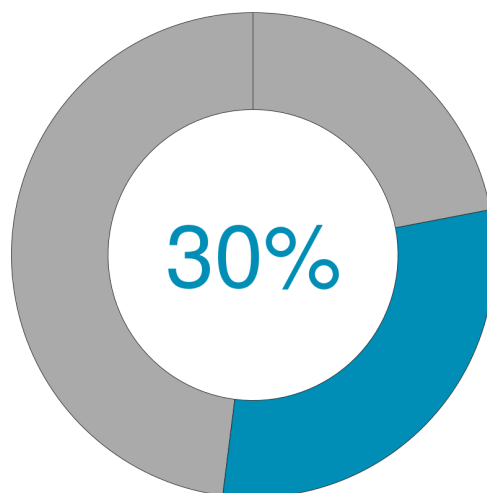
VIOLENT CRIME

22 percent of all crimes in the London region are violent. This includes violent offences, sexual offences and robbery.



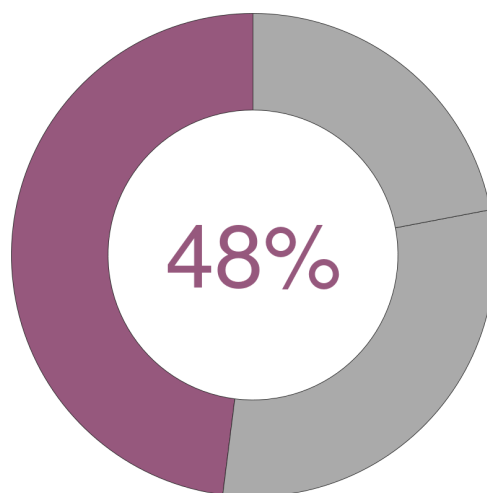
PROPERTY CRIME

30 percent of crimes in the London region involve damage to property or loss of property. This includes burglary, criminal damage and arson, vehicle crimes, and theft.



PUBLIC ORDER

48 percent of reported crimes in the London region entail violations of public order regulations. This includes possession of weapons, drug offences, and public order violations.



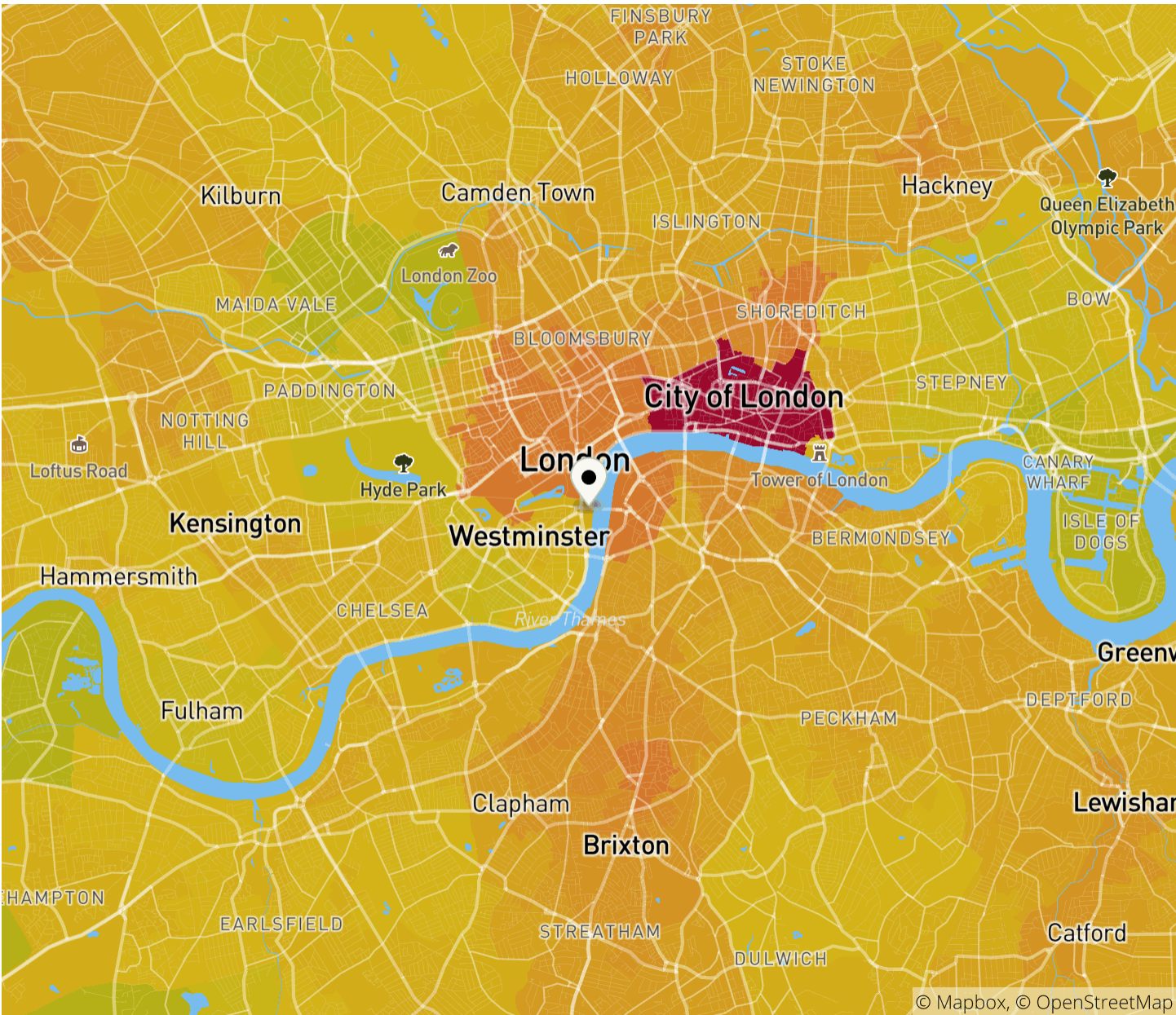

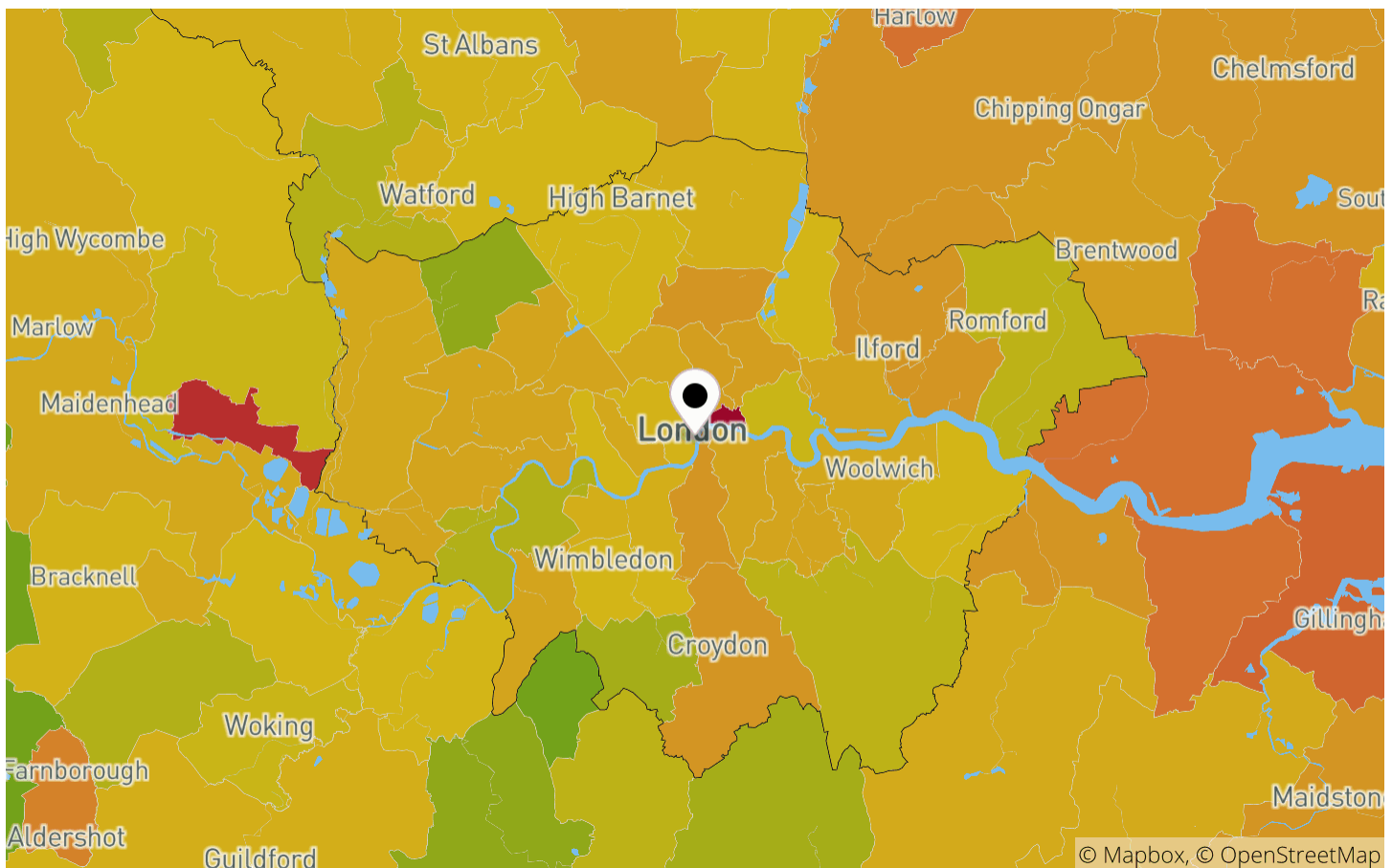

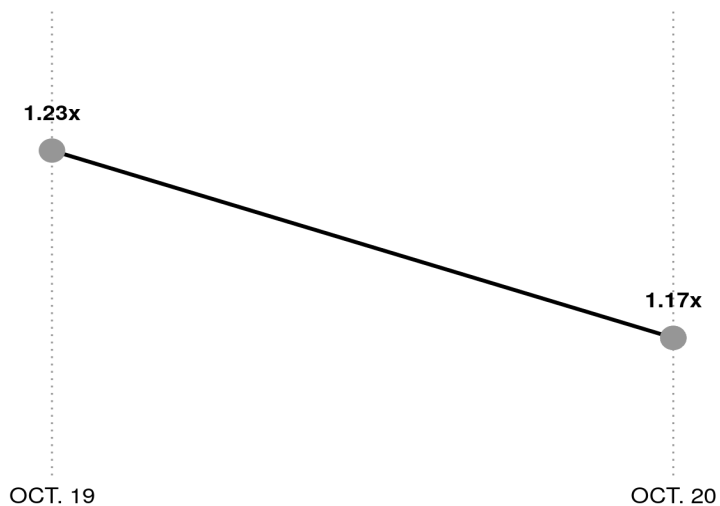
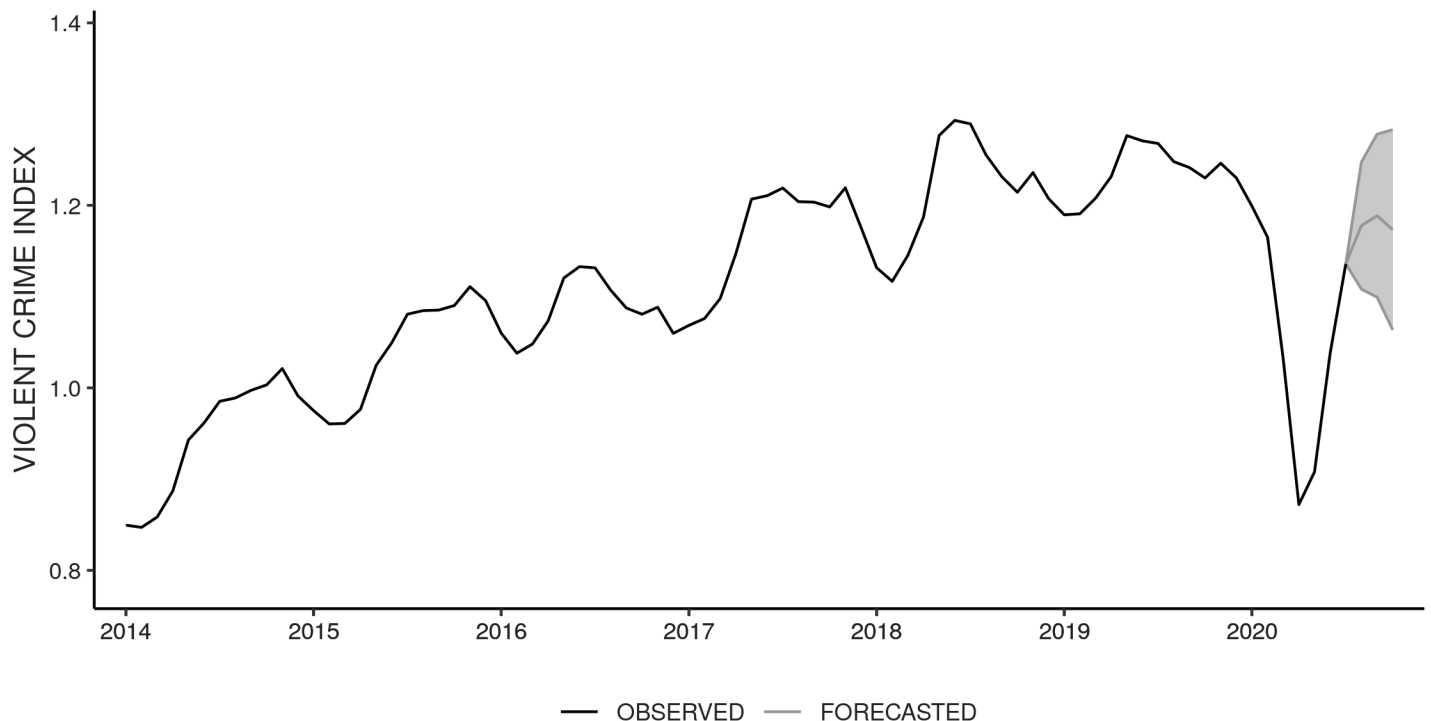

LONDON VIOLENT CRIME RISK OVER TIME

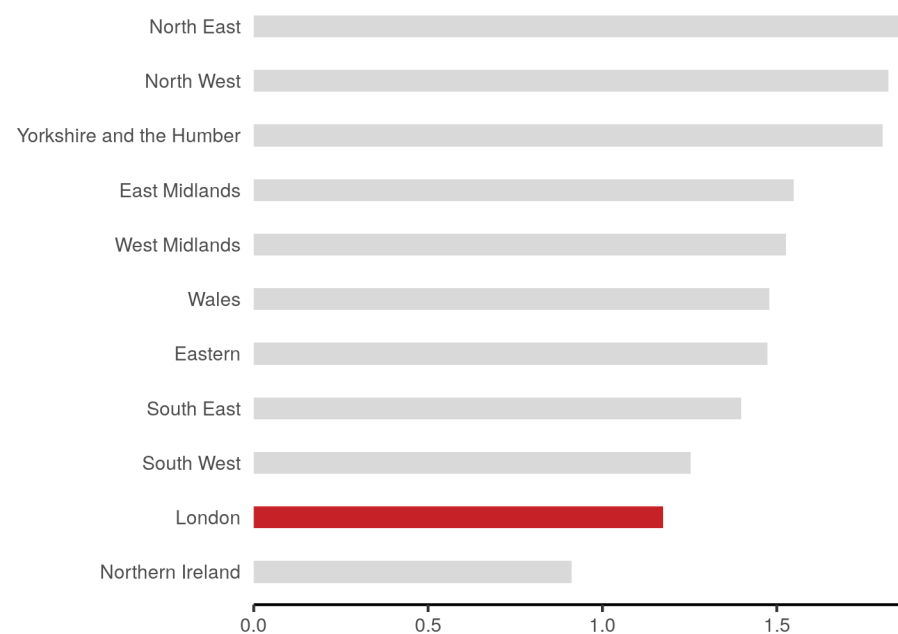
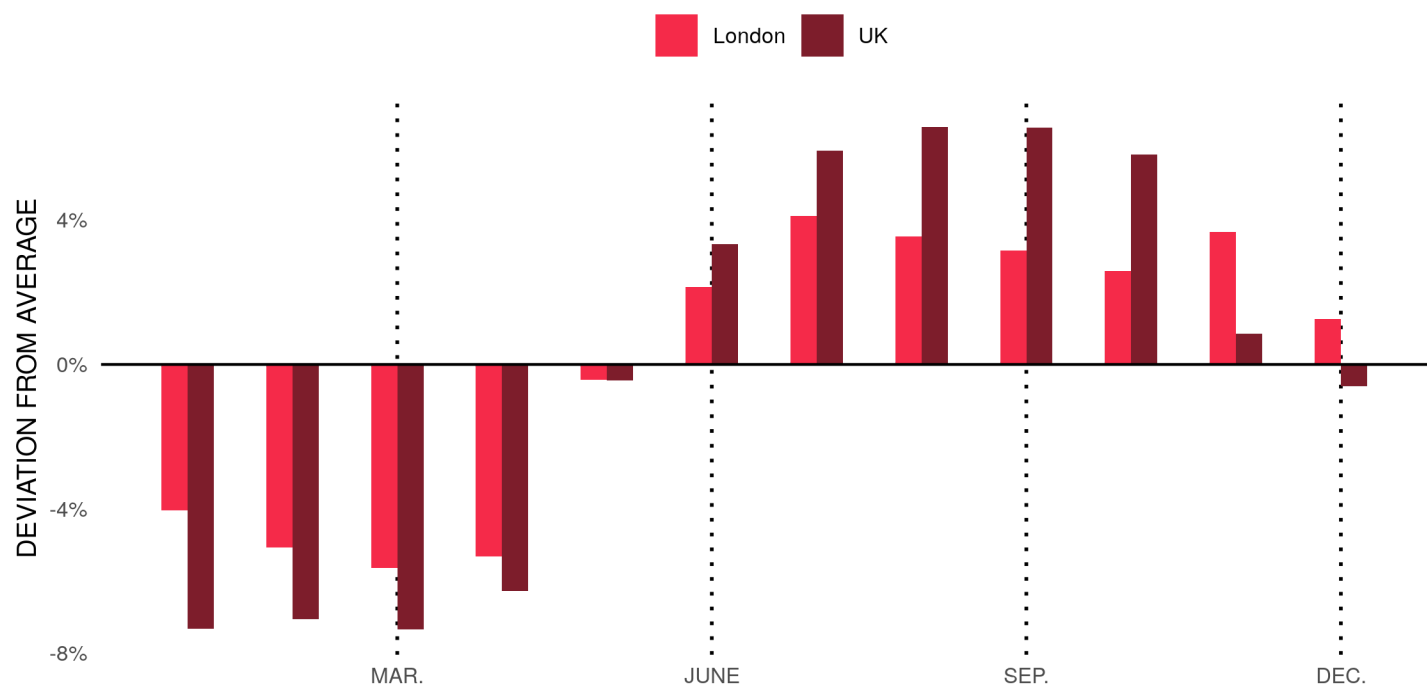

The figure shows violent crime risk across regions in the UK, sorting regions from highest to lowest risk. The London region has the 2nd lowest violent crime risk across the group.

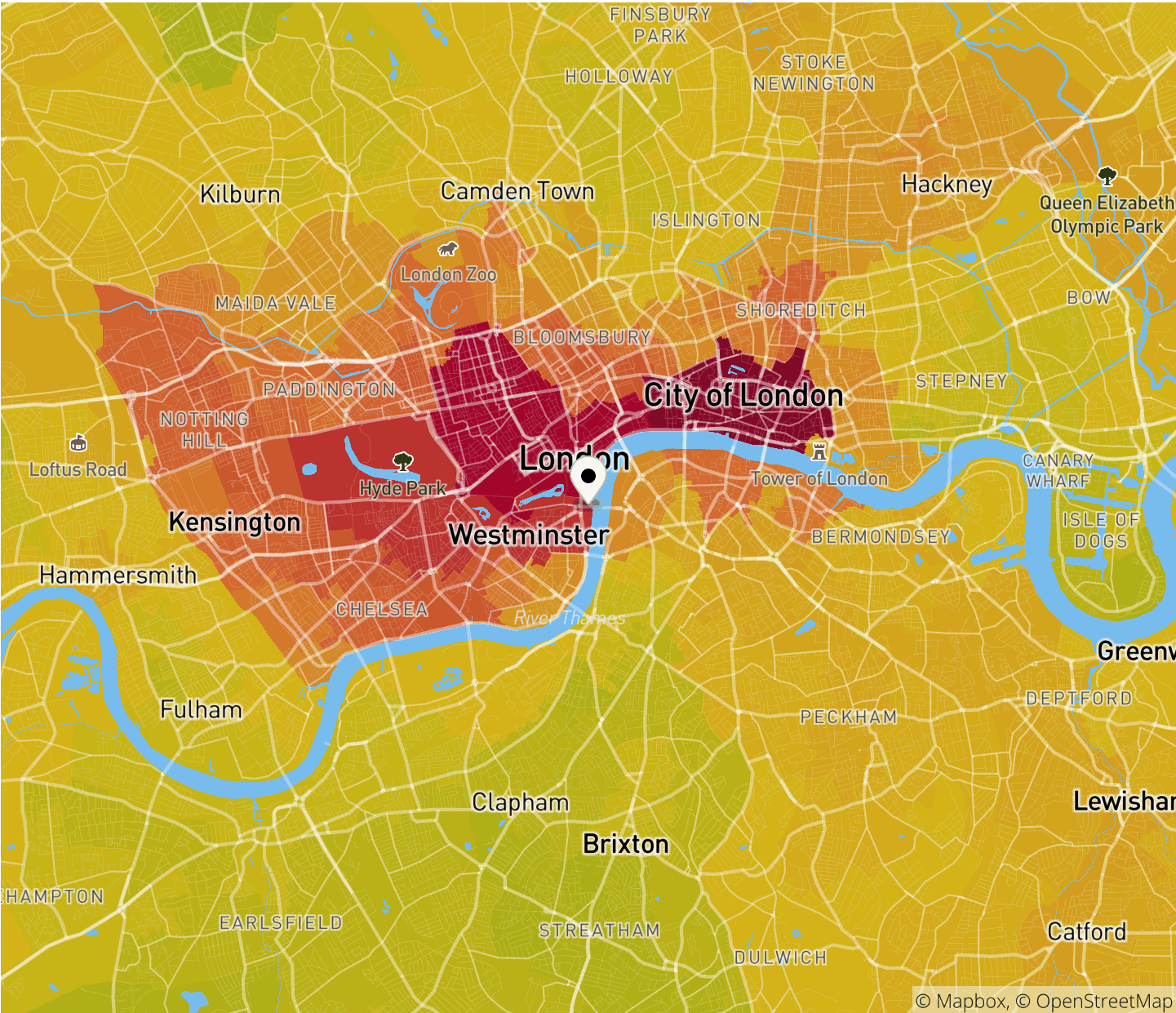

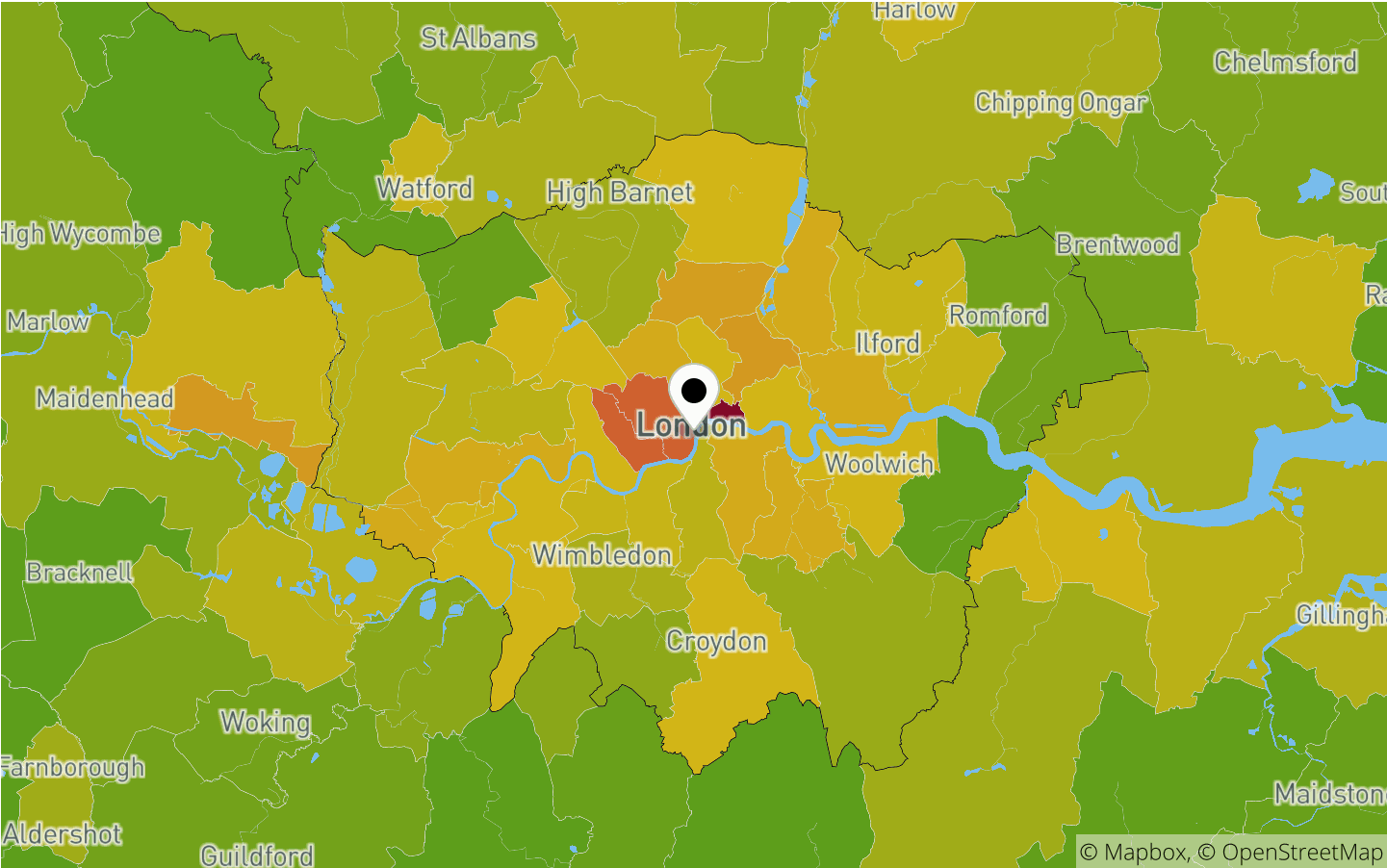

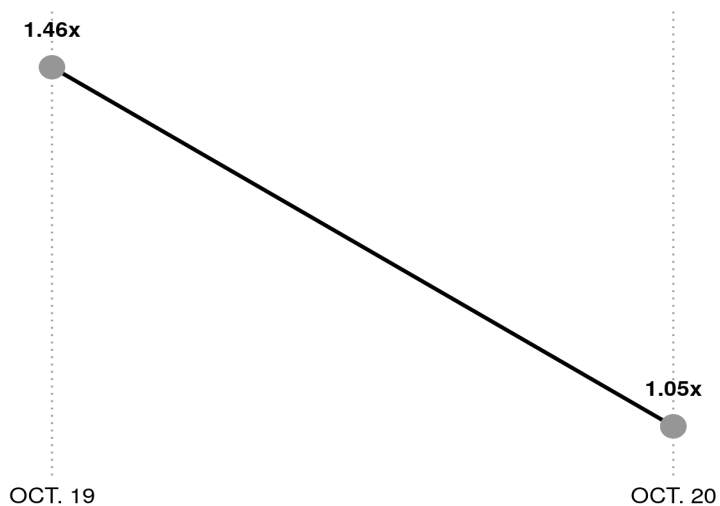
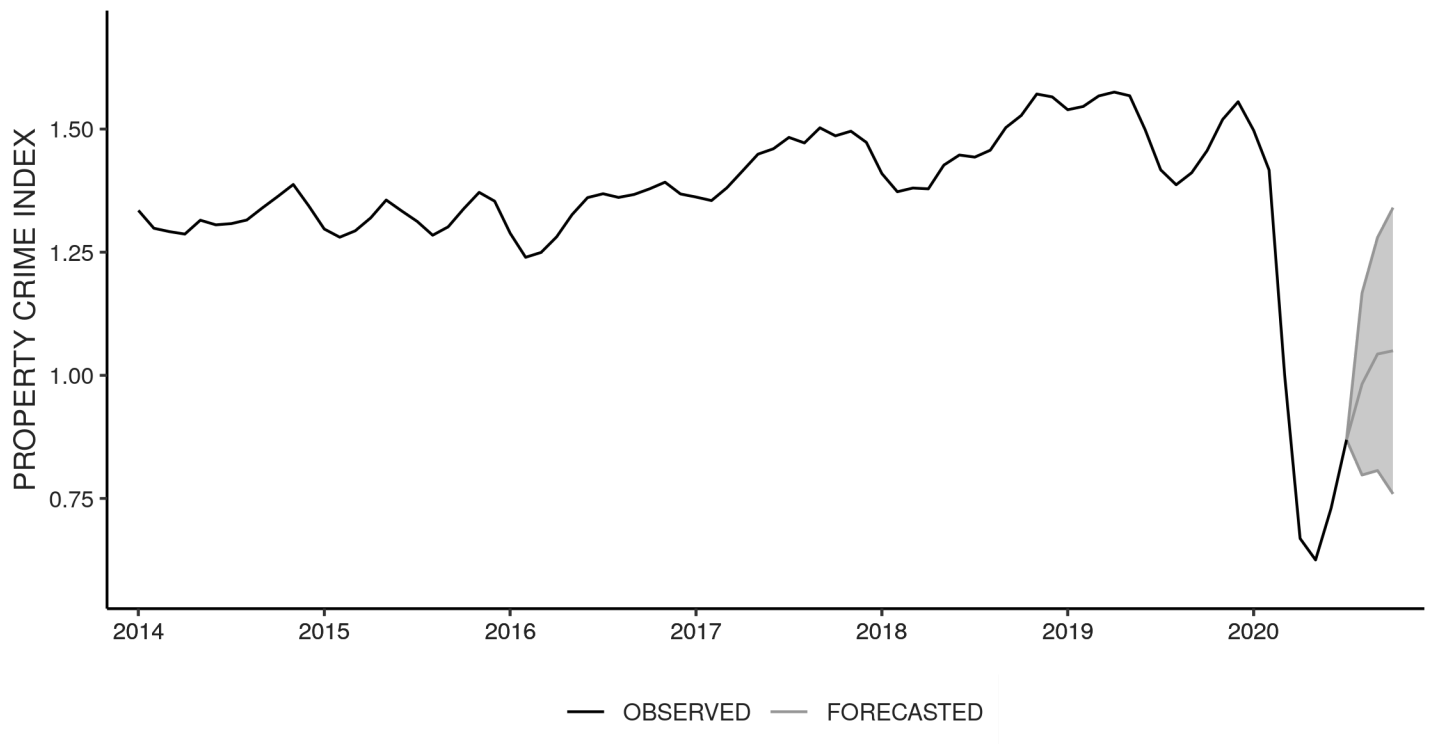

LONDON PROPERTY CRIME RISK OVER TIME

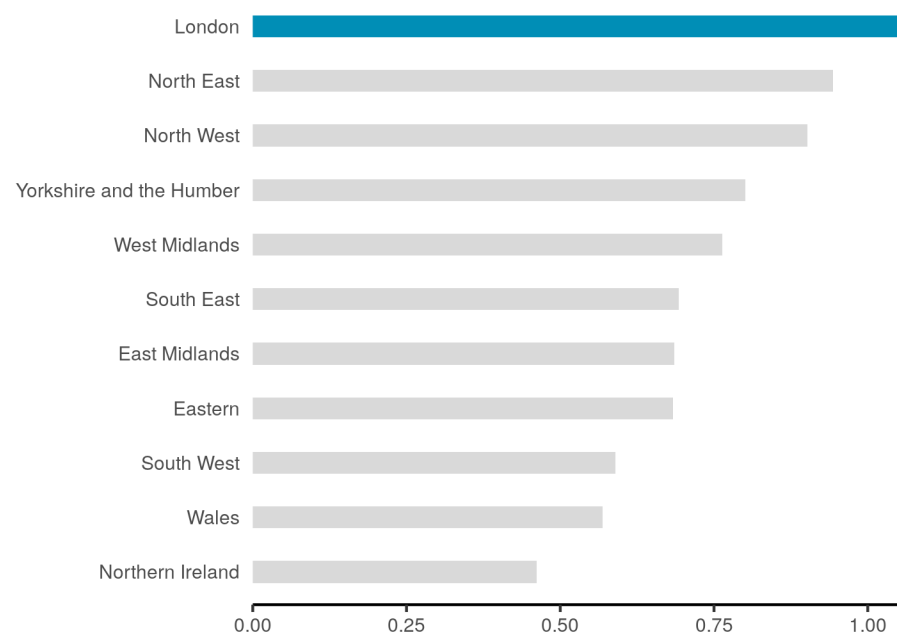

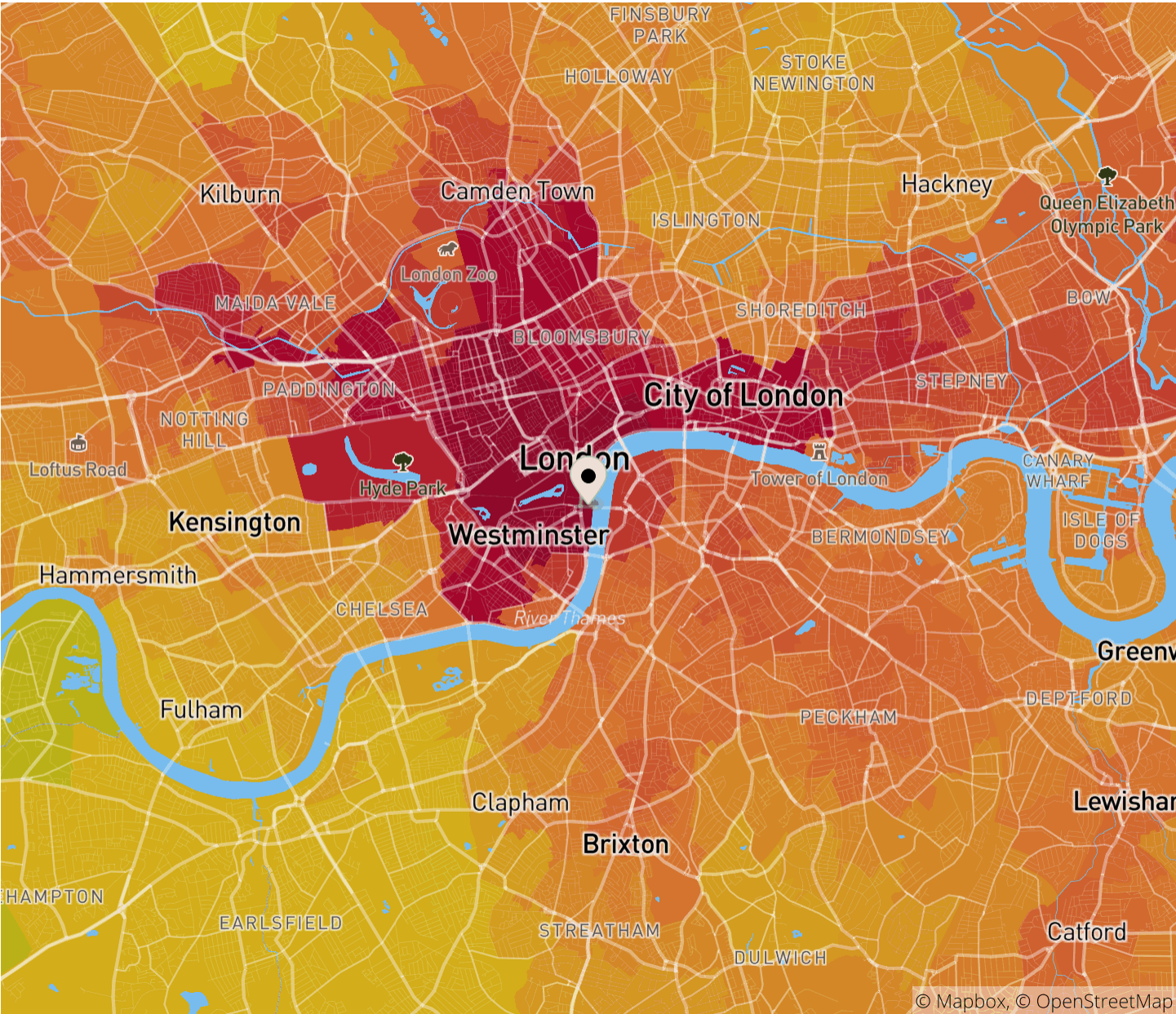

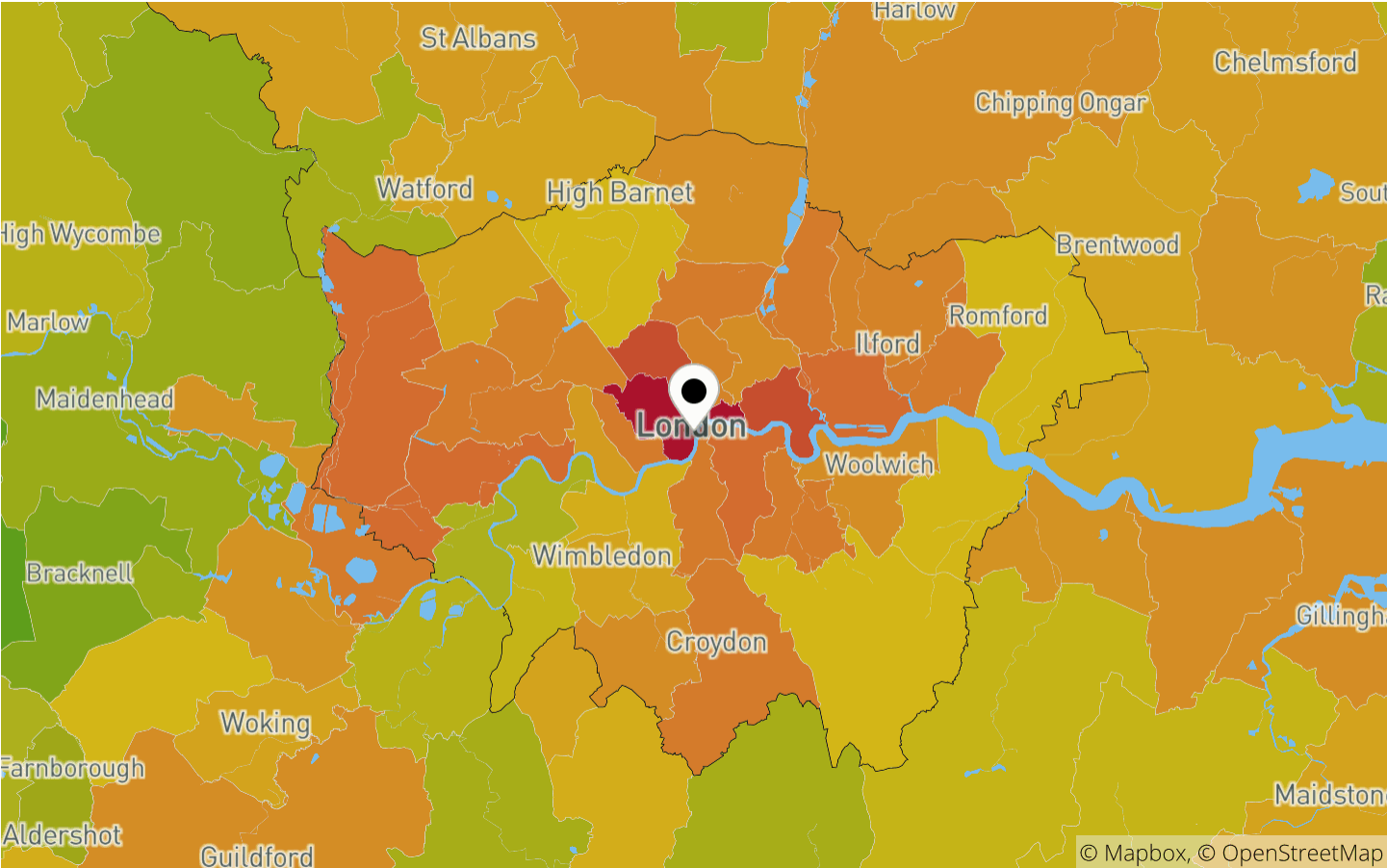

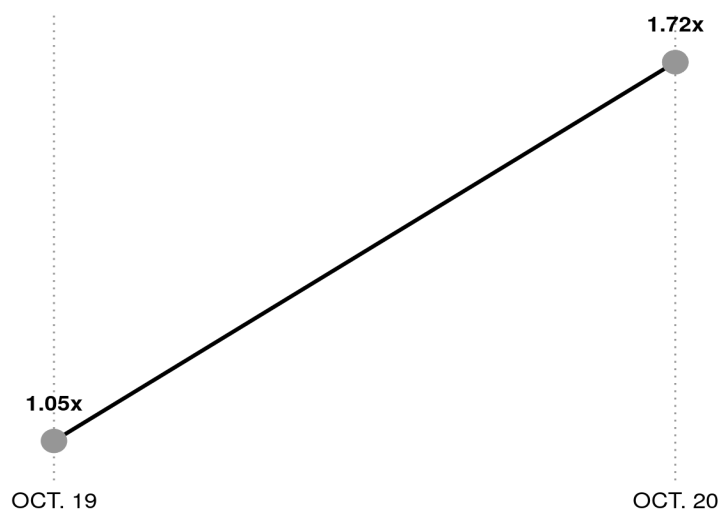
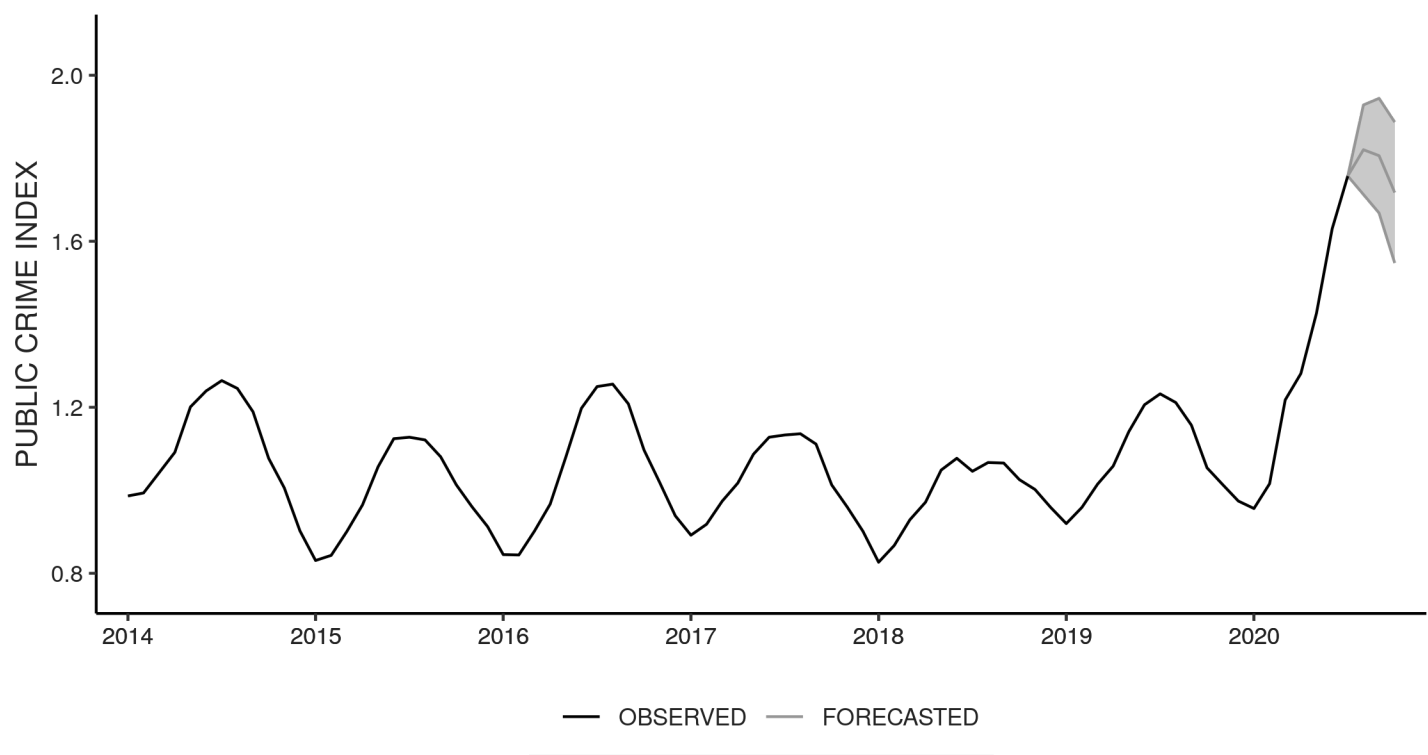

LONDON PUBLIC CRIME RISK OVER TIME

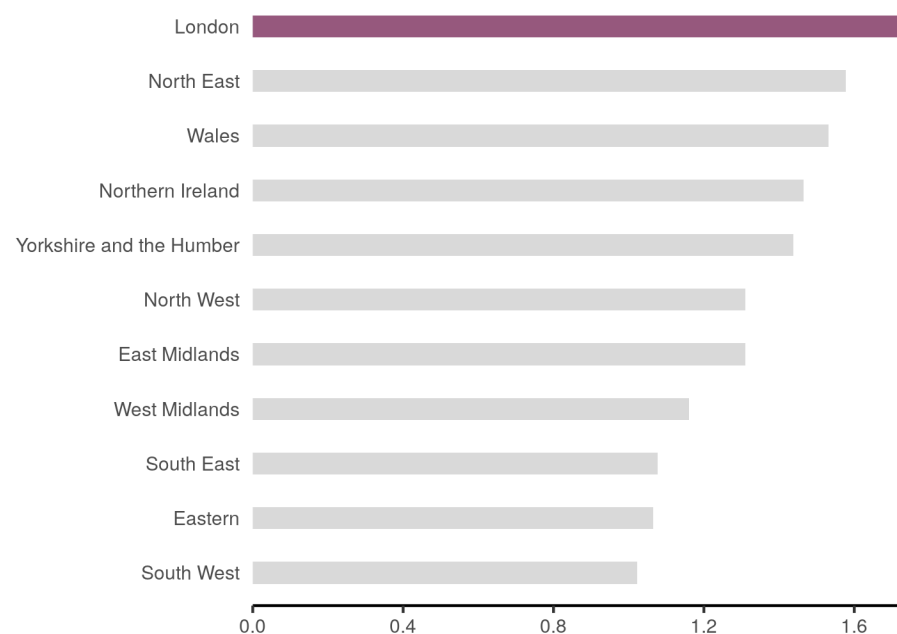
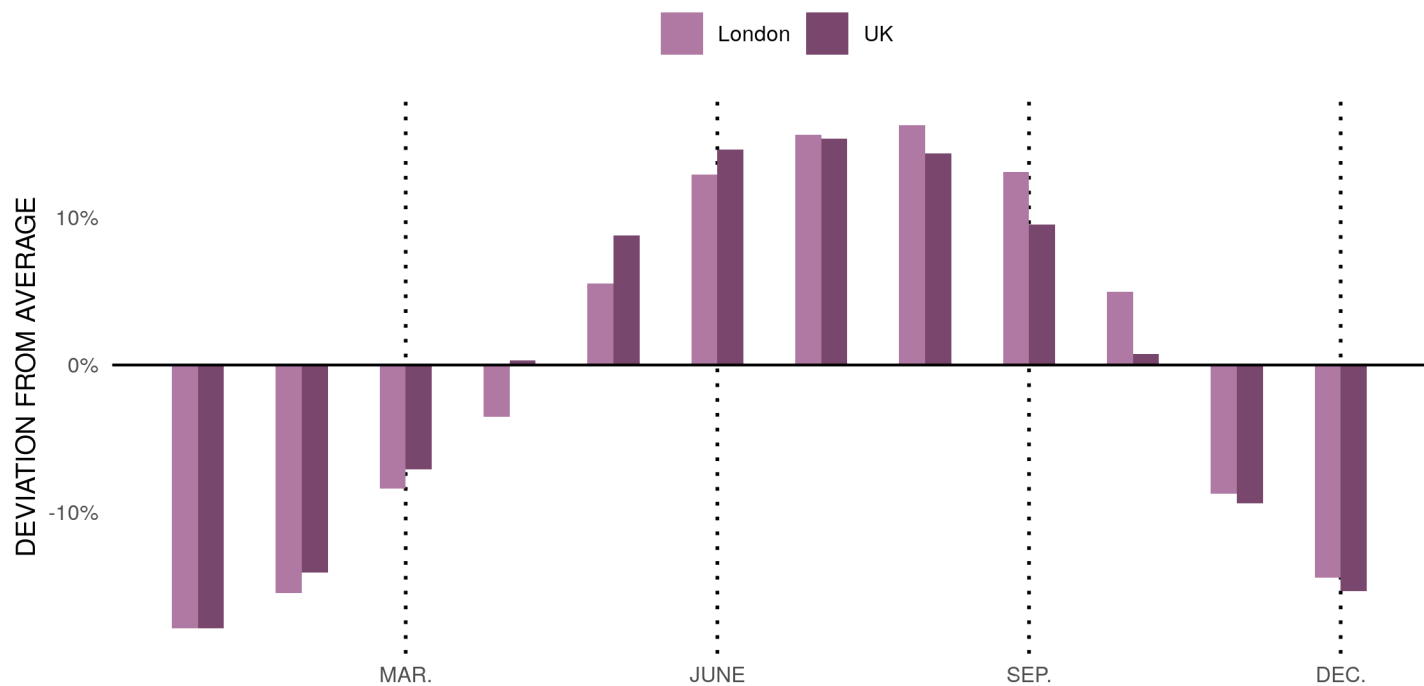
