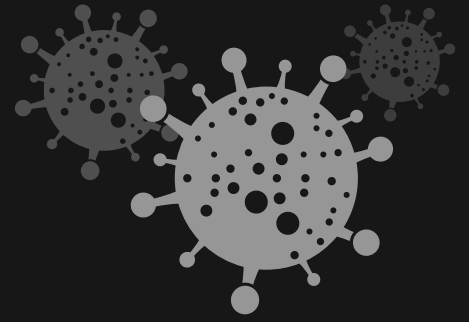


COVID-19 AND THE INCREASED NEED FOR VIGILANCE

- Workplaces have transitioned to remote-only environments

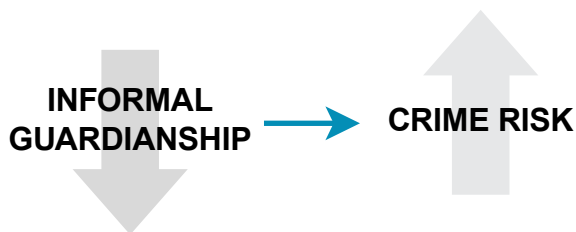

THESE CONCEPTS AID IN PREDICTING HOW CRIME RISK IS CHANGING ACROSS COMMUNITIES

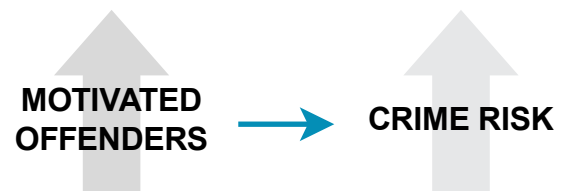


Though sheltering-in-place measures have lowered crime counts in the short run, the economic turmoil caused by lockdowns increases the conditions for crime in the long run
