




The industry has grown faster than the economy both in terms of employment and wages









78% of employment within the industry is in protective services occupations

The protective services occupation includes jobs such as physical site security, gaming surveillance officers, criminal investigators, and armored car personnel.




Of the remaining 22% of jobs





The public sector employs the majority of protective services workers




Over the last decade, growth in protective services has slowed within the public sector. Increasingly, the investigation and security industry has filled the gap.




